

ORDINANCE NO. 07 – 12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELLE ISLE, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 4, OF THE CITY OF BELLE ISLE CODE OF ORDINANCES ADDING A SECTION TO PROHIBIT THE KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Belle Isle City Council has determined it is necessary to amend Chapter 4 of the Belle Isle Code of Ordinances to prohibit the keeping of poultry and livestock in residential districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Belle Isle, Florida as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 4, is hereby amended to add a new section which shall be numbered 4-2 and shall read as follows:

4-2 Poultry and livestock.

(a) Definitions. For the purposes of this section:

"Livestock" shall mean domestic animals typically kept for agricultural uses, such as, but not limited to, pigs, cows, horses, goats, and sheep.

"Poultry" shall mean domestic fowl such as, but not limited to, chickens, roosters, turkeys, ducks, geese, pigeons, hens, quails, pheasants and squabs.

(b) The keeping of poultry or livestock is prohibited in all residential districts.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. If any word, phrase, sentence, clause or other portion of this Ordinance is determined to be invalid, void or unconstitutional, the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in effect.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
